MACSP members are invited to submit up to five pieces of artwork. Submissions will include programs serving children and adults.

The following art media will be accepted: Painting/drawing, Photography, Small sculpture, Fiber/textile and Jewelry.

The following are due no later than March 9th:

- To defray the costs associated with the exhibit, there will be a \$10.00 entry fee for each submission. Checks should be made payable to GMS and include "Lest We Forget" in the memo section of the check and mailed to: Ann-Marie Mayberry, GMS, PO Box 1280, Westbrook, ME 04098
- The Attached entry form, logo and artist picture must be complete and sent via email to jharmon@gmsme.org. Please use "LWF2018-Agency name- artist initials" in the subject line for all email correspondence related to this event.
- Digital agency logo
- A quality digital image of the artists' face only.

ART MUST BE DROPPED OFF NO LATER THAN March 9th. Artwork must be clearly labeled on the back with artist's name, title of piece, and agency. All art must be exhibit ready (framed, mounted, etc.) We are not able to accept artwork that exceeds 36" x 36" or weighs more than 15 pounds.
