Dan Habib Creator of award-winning documentary films *Including Samuel*, *Who Cares About Kelsey?*, *Mr. Connolly Has ALS*, and many other short films on disability-related topics. In 2014, he was appointed by President Obama to the President's Committee for People with Intellectual Disabilities - a committee that promotes initiatives that support independence and lifelong inclusion of people with intellectual disabilities.

Alice Brouhard, RN, is a champion of the use of technology, especially tablet technology, to support people with memory and cognitive challenges. She has worked tirelessly to set up a system that allows her daughter who sustained a serious TBI to live independently despite significant disabilities.

Than Johnson has been the CEO of CRSI since 1983. His career began as Residential Administrator for the Preble County Board of DD, followed by serving as Program Administrator with the Ohio Department of DD, before joining CRSI. He has served on many boards including Ancor and OPRA, while advocating for the benefit and human rights of people with disabilities.

Barb Turner is the former Senior Director of External Affairs at ARRM in Minnesota, and has worked for over 35 years in the disability field. Barb has promoted using technology in providing services, including drafting legislation, working on rate setting issues, sharing successes with interested stakeholders and providing technical assistance to providers.

Dustin Wright is the founder of Disability Cocoon and was one of the original pioneers of remote support services in 2006. He has worked in disability services/supports for 20+ years.
